This term we have to say goodbye to some of our staff.

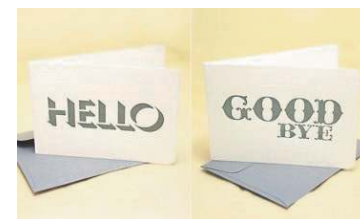
Miss West is leaving to spend some time with her family.
