

Brandles School Transport Code of Behaviour

- All drivers and vehicles used for transporting pupils to and from school are employed as school transport and drivers, not taxis.
- All drivers are directly responsible to the County Transport Manager or Headteacher/School representative.
- The School day starts at 9.00am and finishes at 3.30pm.
- Pupils will wear seat belts and remain seated for through their journey to and from school.
- Pupils are not permitted to leave their taxi, unless it is to exit at school or home. (ie. asking to go to the shops, be dropped at a different address, take a break)
- Pupils are expected to respect the taxi driver and vehicle. (shouting out comments to passing public, verbally abusing the driver, eating or drinking in the taxi etc).
- Should a pupil fail to keep our taxi code of conduct, they could face a temporary ban, or in more serious cases a permanent ban from the taxi.
